
# The Faith Of Seventh-Day Adventist Christians

- We acknowledge the sovereignty of God's Law, not as a means of salvation but as a result of conduct; including the observance of the Seventh-day Sabbath.
- We believe that, according to the bible and spirit of prophesy, the Second Advent of Christ is imminent. We accept the guidance of the Holy Spirit; The Third person of the God
- We acknowledge the Health Message, according to the Holy Scripture and the Spirit Of Prophesy as a Christian message to be taught and lived, and we accept it as part of God's news for the redemption of man.
- All who enter the Kingdom of God must have experienced conversion, or the new birth, through which man receives a new heart & becomes a new creature. Thus, regardless of ethnic or social background, he becomes a new member of the family in Heaven & on Earth.
